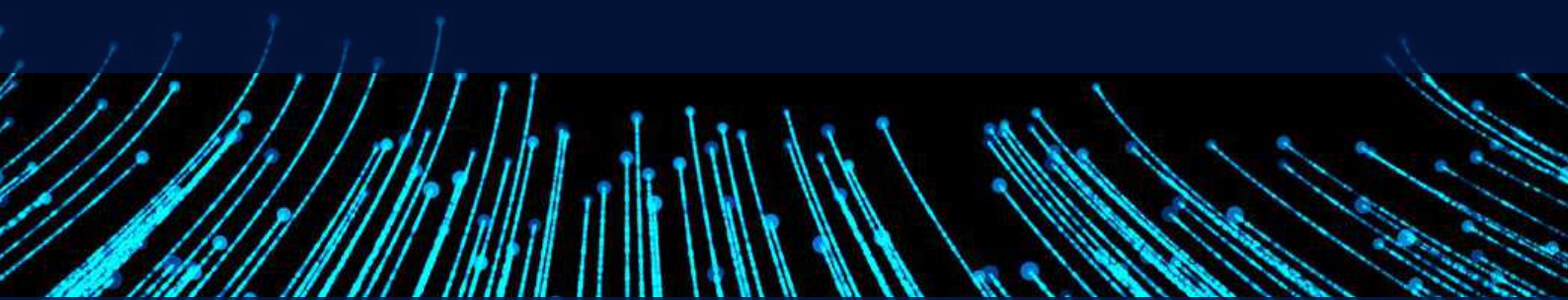

BACKGROUND

Considerable excitement and trepidation have surrounded the advent of the global development of data protection laws. As the global economy shifts further into a connected information space, the relevance of data protection and the need for controlling privacy will further increase.

One example is the popular social media app, Tiktok, owned by Beijing-based Bytedance. The app is under increasing scrutiny in overseas markets, especially in the United States and India where it has become a lightning rod in disputes among global powers as data protection is now a pre-eminent aspect of state security concerns.
